BACKGROUND

In connection with the works carried out at the National Rehabilitation Site in Loughborough, MAC recently donated excess insulation materials to local farmers situated close to the construction site. This donation was carried out in conjunction with CLEAR Engagement who exist to deliver real, sustainable, social and environmental change for people, communities and businesses.

In total MAC donated over £30,000 worth of insulated panels, and arrangements were made for the farmers to come and collect the materials which they will be using to build a new barn.
